She was raised in Geza Banda, Asmara, and attended Emperor Haile Selassie High School. She later graduated from the Nursing School of Asmara in 1980. She earned a degree in Nursing and began her career at the Ministry of Health in Asmara, where she worked from 1980 to 2007. On September 6, 1991, Sister Zufan married Mr. Beyan Tesfagiorgis in a church ceremony at Geza Kenisha. They were blessed with four children: Yonathan, Mesfun, Betiel, and Ghideon. Zufan migrated to the United States in March of 2007. Upon arrival in the U.S., she pursued further education in nursing, obtaining her Registered Nurse (RN) license.
