Tommy went by many names to the family and friends that loved him, but he was most fondly referred to as Dad, Pops, or Grandpa. He was happiest when spending time with his kids or supporting his grandkids in their various activities.

Tommy was born November 12, 1949 in Houston, Texas to Thomas Milton Harrington and Anne Valuna Harrington. He graduated from Stephen F. Austin High School in Houston, TX in 1968. Throughout his high school years, he could be found with his best friends Jackie and Jerry, who they called the "Three Musketeers".
