Dr. Ragsdale is preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his college sweetheart and loving wife of 60 years, Dorothy Ragsdale; daughter Dr. Sally Landon and her husband Scott Landon, sons Charles and Brian, grandson, Joe Meyer and sister, Dr. Frances Brock and numerous nieces and nephews. Dr. Ragsdale graduated from Lamar University and was a proud member of the Sigma Nu fraternity.
