He was an active member of St. John's Episcopal Church in La Porte, Texas where he sang in the choir and served on the vestry. Paul grew up sailing on Lake Erie and loved sailboat racing and cruising on Galveston Bay. He was active at the Houston Yacht Club and served as Commodore in 1985.
