Robinson "Bob" Capen, age 95, was received into God's loving arms on November 21, 2017. Bob was born March 15, 1922, in Winsted, Connecticut, the only child of Gertrude Robinson and Nathan Odell Capen. Bob began his education in Connecticut and Maine before joining the Navy, serving in the Pacific as a Seabee during WWII. After the war, Bob continued his education in Georgia, graduating as a mechanical engineer from Georgia Tech. While in Georgia he met the light of his life, Pauline Pence. They were married June 10, 1947. They resided in Georgia and then Louisiana where they raised their three children. In 1978 a new career opportunity settled them in LaPorte, Texas. After 46 years of marriage, Pauline departed this earth to be with Jesus in heaven. By God's grace, another angel entered Bob's life, Marian McCorquodale. They were married March 4, 1995, and enjoyed 14 happy years together before Marian also joined Jesus. Bob was a just and kind man who loved his Lord, his family, and helping others. He was a respected leader in his community and was a stronghold for his family. Bob spent his career as a plant operations manager, working with Plantation Pipe Line, Foster Grant, and Ohmstede. He served his community throughout his life including positions as Lion's Club District Governor, Rotary President, and service on many civic, financial, and industrial boards. Bob never met a stranger, and was a friend and mentor to many. He was a fixer, helper, tinkerer, and always involved. Bob profoundly loved God and his family and they were the center of his life.
