Alonzo "Lonny" Obed Meadows Jr. - Age 60 of Pearland, TX and long-time native of LaPorte, TX passed away April 18, 2017, after a courageous battle against cancer. Lonny passed at home with his beloved family and five german shorthaired pointers by his side. Born in Great Lakes, IL he spent most of his time in Baytown, TX before moving to LaPorte and graduating from LaPorte High School; as did his wife and children.
