He eventually married in Abilene and Dave got a job at Texaco as a Mechanical Engineer in Port Arthur. Later they moved to Victoria with a new job at Union Carbide in Seadrift, Texas as a Computer Engineer. Dave was devoted to his family and would even go shopping with his daughter for hours at a time. He was a quiet servant, never drawing attention to himself. Dave believes there is a purpose in everything, even his diagnosis with parkinson's and later with dementia. He was an inspiration to others, a fighter who never complained. He will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.
