Kenyon Pearce Lewis, 20, died at home in La Porte, Texas, on April 2, 2015. Setting a high standard for himself, Kenyon was an Eagle Scout who graduated fifth in his 2013 class of more than 500 at La Porte High School. He balanced a passion for books with love of nature and the outdoors, and joy in playing with his niece, Tori. Even as he struggled in confusing times, his unique, generous spirit touched many. Kenyon is survived by his mother, Dawn Pearce Lewis, and partner Jerry Lemon of La Porte, Texas; his father, David K. Lewis, of Rye, Texas; his sister, brother-in-law and niece, Jenna Hargraves Pinkston, Michael Pinkston and Tori Pinkston, of San Marcos, Texas; grandparents Donald K. Lewis and Pat Lewis of Forest Park, Georgia; as well as uncles, aunts and cousins. Kenyon was preceded in death by Grandmother Rose Lewis and Grandparents, Mickey and Ralph Pearce. The family has set up a scholarship fund in Kenyon's name through La Porte High School.
