Margaret Marie Atkins Reep, a wonderful mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister and aunt, went peacefully to be with her Lord on Sept. 30, 2014, in DeSoto, Texas. She was 89.

She was born Margaret Marie Atkins to Victor Ray Atkins and Alice Modena Atkins on April 25, 1925, in Green Hill, Texas. She married the late Noel G.
