Lawrence Paul Cobble, Jr., 88, passed away on October 22, 2012 from complications of Parkinson's disease. He was a resident of Pearland for more than 44 years. Larry was born in Springfield, Missouri October 1, 1924 to parents Martha Moore and Lawrence Paul Cobble, Sr. He was preceded in death by his parents and daughter Carolyn Ann Cobble.
