Robert Lee Biaza, known by many as Bob, passed away July 16, 2010, in Baytown.

Robert was born June 26, 1929, in Sabastain Fla. He moved to La Porte during his high school years, and La Porte remained his home for the next 58 years until hurricane Ike forced him to relocate to Baytown.

Robert served in the U.S Navy from 1948-1952 and worked at Rohm & Haas as an operator for 42 years.

He had many business interests in La Porte, Morgan's Point and Seabrook, such as Bob's Ice House, and he co-owned and built The Point and La Porte Super Food Center. Being an avid sports fan he enjoyed any sport ending with the word ball in it and loved horse racing.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Frank and Carrie Biaza, his son, Robin, and daughter-in law, Peggy.
