Robert "Bob" Paul Schwartz Sr., age 74, of Pearland, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on September 17, 2009 at his home in Country Place. He is preceded in death by his father, Edward & Alice (Plenzler) Schwartz; and brother, Edward Schwartz Jr. He is survived by his loving wife, Dolores; son, Robert Schwartz Jr.; daughter Leanne Renfro & her husband Paul; Brother Jerome Schwartz; and a host of many other family & friends.

Bob was born on June 2, 1935 in Chicago, Illinois. He resided in Itasca, IL until 1965 when he and his family moved to Naples, Florida until 1981, when he settled in the Houston area. In 1986 they moved to Country Place, where they have made many friends. Bob served in the Military for 2 years stationed in Baltimore, MD. He was assigned to the Nike Guided Missile Unit covering the Washington, D.C. area.
